PINK TACO INSIDE HARD ROCK HOTEL & CASINO

Known for putting a California spin on traditional Mexican dishes, Pink Taco now serves breakfast daily from 7-11 a.m. Early-riser items include the lip-smacking Huevos Rancheros served with papas y chorizos and the savory Carne con Huevos: tender, grilled marinated skirt steak served with two eggs any style, papas y chorizos and corn or flour tortillas. Whatever dish you decide on, be sure to order the Sopapilla con Miel for the table—Mexican fry bread sprinkled with honey and powdered sugar and served with a housemade fruit compote that's simply to die for!



Dick's Last Resort

DICK'S LAST RESORT INSIDE EXCALIBUR

Famous for its rowdy wait staff and deliciously messy cuisine, Dick's Last Resort now serves breakfast daily from 8 a.m.-noon. In addition to a selection of "Hangover Specials" like the filling French Toast & Eggs—four wedges of French toast and three eggs served your way with choice of bacon, sausage or ham and a side of Dick's flavorful breakfast potatoes—the restaurant offers a "Rug Rat's Breakfast" for kids 12 and younger, making Dick's ideal for both families and those looking for a good time. After all, where else can you get balloon animals and paper hats with funny double entendres written on them with your morning mimosa?
